- Comm. Fournier Budget created for compliance and overtime. 51 tickets written at CK Lot. Deputies will show more compliance
- Comm. Fournier County creating a fireworks ordinance Comm. Fournier and Sheriff Brown collaborating, instead of just beaches, it will include all of unincorporated areas.
- Comm. Fournier Parking ordinance set up like a C violation. Makes an officer more likely to write ticket (take less time).
